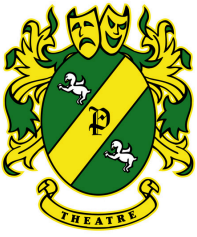
A note from the director:

THE OUTSIDERS WAS BROUGHT TO ME AS A SHOW IDEA BY STUDENTS WHO HAD READ THE BOOK FOR THEIR SEVENTH GRADE ENGLISH CLASSES. STUDENTS TALKED ABOUT THE OUTSIDERS WITH SUCH ENTHUSIASM AND EXCITEMENT, AND AFTER EXPLORING THE SCRIPT, I UNDERSTOOD WHY. THOUGH THE BEHAVIORS AND EXPERIENCES OF THE CHARACTERS IN THE OUTSIDERS, HAVE NOT BEEN EXPERIENCED BY OUR STUDENTS, THE RELATIONSHIPS, AND THE CHARACTERS' SEARCH FOR UNDERSTANDING AND ACCEPTANCE IS FAMILIAR TO THEM.

THE OUTSIDERS IS ALL ABOUT SEEING PAST THE SURFACE, AND DEEPER INTO WHO PEOPLE REALLY ARE. WE DISCOVER THROUGH OUR STORY THAT EACH CHARACTER IS MORE THAN A "SOC" OR "GREASER"- THEY ARE JUST PEOPLE. PEOPLE WITH GOOD SIDES AND BAD SIDES, FEARS AND HOPES. THE STORY ENCOURAGES US TO BREAK DOWN BARRIERS AND EXPLORE THAT EVERY PERSON NEEDS FRIENDSHIP, LOYALTY, AND THE NEED TO BELONG.

THANK YOU FOR SUPPORTING THESE STUDENTS AND THE WORK THEY HAVE POURED INTO BRINGING THIS STORY TO LIFE. WE HOPE THIS PERFORMANCE REMINDS YOU, THAT CONNECTION IS ALWAYS POSSIBLE, AND THAT EVEN IN THE HARDEST MOMENTS, THERE IS STILL ROOM TO "STAY GOLD."

Scene Breakdown


ACT I: The show opens with Ponyboy speaking on the phone in his home. It introduces his brothers and a few friends by showing them hanging out at home.

They end up going to a drive-in movie where the terms “greasers” and “socs” are brought up into more depth. After the movie they walk home, which is when the climax begins.

Ponyboy arrives home late, leading to dramatic problems. Act I ends with Ponyboy facing a traumatic conflict.

ACT II: Ponyboy tries to escape the conflict, so he leaves. He ends up in an abandoned church. Another dilemma occurs, causing much anguish toward Ponyboy.

The show ends with Ponyboy, once again, speaking on the phone. He starts to write in a notebook and talk about everything that happened and all of the suffering he faced.
