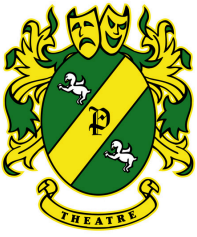

Smoking is strictly prohibited on all Springfield Public Schools Property including Parkview High School.

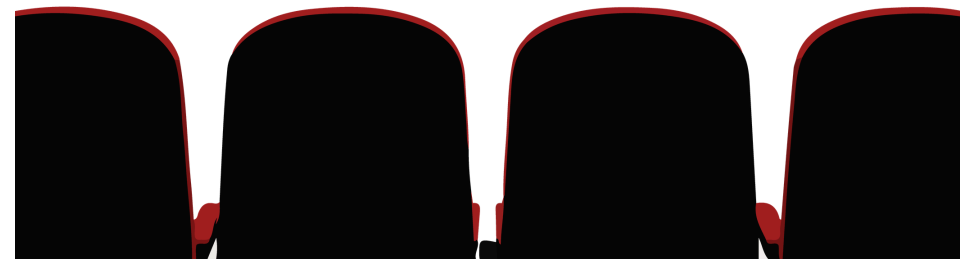
